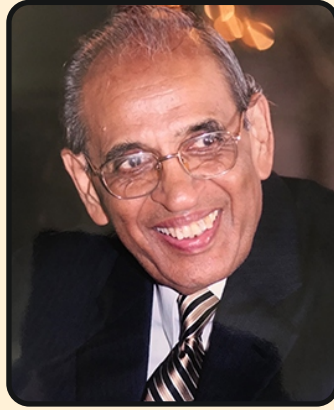

Memorial Lecture Honoree



Late Justice SC Agrawal

(Former Judge, Supreme Court of India)

Late Justice SC Agrawal (1933-2021) was a renowned Judge of Supreme Court of India & the Rajasthan High Court. He served as President of Rajasthan Education Trust and was also the founding trustee of CL Agrawal Memorial (CLAM) Library Trust, Rajasthan High Court, Jaipur. Justice Agrawal was born in Jaipur in 1933. After finishing his LLB studies from University of Rajasthan, he did his LLM from the University of London and became Bar-At-Law in 1957. He joined the Supreme Court of India Bar in 1959. He was appointed Additional Judge of the Rajasthan High Court on 15th June 1978 from where he was elevated to Supreme Court of India "SCI" on 11th Jan. 1990. He retired from the SCI in September 1998. He delivered several landmark judgements both at Rajasthan High Court and Supreme Court and commanded great respect as an eminent Judge of both courts. After his retirement from SCI, he engaged himself in several charity activities continuing the legacy of his father Late Sh. Chiranji Lal Agrawal (Advocate) through Rajasthan Education Trust, where he served as President till his passing away in July 2021. He also served as President of Association of Retired Judges of Supreme Court & High Courts of India for two years. He donated his entire property to charity.

Keynote Speaker



Hon'ble Justice Hima Kohli

(Former Judge, Supreme Court of India)

Justice Hima Kohli is a former Judge of the Supreme Court of India, known for her distinguished judicial career spanning over four decades. Enrolled as an Advocate in 1984, she practiced extensively before the Delhi High Court, handling matters of constitutional law, commercial disputes, and public importance. She was elevated as a Judge of the Delhi High Court in 2006, marking the beginning of her long and impactful tenure in the judiciary. During her service in the High Court of Delhi, Justice Kohli held several significant administrative and institutional roles, including Executive Chairperson of the Delhi State Legal Services Authority. She later made history as the first woman Chief Justice of the High Court for the State of Telangana in January 2021, where she played a key role in strengthening arbitration infrastructure, notably contributing to the establishment of the International Arbitration and Mediation Centre (IAMC), Hyderabad. Justice Kohli was appointed to the Supreme Court of India on 31 August 2021, becoming the first woman judge elevated from the Delhi High Court to the apex court. During her tenure, she chaired important committees, including those on Gender Sensitization and Family Courts, and gained international recognition as a certified Specialist Mediator by the Singapore International Mediation Centre. Post-retirement, she continues to actively contribute to arbitration, mediation, legal education, and academic discourse at national and international levels.
